FELLOWSHIP TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP

The College Fellowship Scholarship was established in 1992 to encourage and assist Members of the College to proceed to Fellowship. One or more Scholarships may be awarded each year.

1. The ANZCVS scholarship is awarded to provide financial support for candidates to achieve the supervised training required for the Fellowship training program.
2. The scholarship is open to any College Member who has had a training program accepted by the Fellowship Training and Credentials Committee, and is actively pursuing training towards the Fellowship.
3. The scholarship shall have the value of AU\$10,254.00 in 2023 and shall be awarded annually by, and at the discretion of, the College Council. The Scholarship recipient will be chosen by the Awards Committee.
4. The scholarship will be judged equally on merit and financial need. The Awards Committee will deem merit to include academic record, publications, presentations and achievements of the applicants in veterinary science. Applicants are not asked to submit letters of reference; however, the Awards Committee may seek the opinions of supervisors and others familiar with the work of the applicant in making their decision. If there is a conflict of interest between any of the applicants and the Awards Committee, then a non-conflicted member of the Council of ANZCVS will be recruited into the committee on a temporary basis.
5. Applicants shall submit the following:
 - a. a current curriculum vitae
 - b. a summary of all current sources of income including but not limited to salary, other traineeships, scholarships and awards, and grants
 - c. a cover letter which may include any special circumstances of need.
6. The College accepts no liability for any actions of the awardee during the period of training.
7. The scholarships shall be advertised in the College Courier and applications shall close with the Secretary on **28 February** in the year in which the award is made.
8. The award of the scholarship will be made at the College Awards Ceremony.
9. The Scholarship will be made in a single payment at the first Awards Ceremony after the determination of the scholarship.
10. It is expected that candidates receiving the scholarship will attempt the Fellowship examination within five years of the date of receipt of the scholarship.
