POLICY ON THE USE OF COLLEGE POSTNOMINALS

- 1. A veterinarian who has passed examinations and been admitted to Membership of the College shall be entitled to use the letters MANZCVS after his/her name, with the appropriate subject added in brackets. e.g. MANZCVS (Small Animal Medicine)
- 2. A veterinarian who has passed more than one membership examination shall be entitled to use MANZCVS only once, after which the subjects are to be listed alphabetically e.g. MANZCVS (Anaesthesia, Small Animal Medicine).
- 3. A veterinarian who has passed examinations and been admitted to Fellowship of the College shall be entitled to use the letters FANZCVS after his/her name, with the appropriate subject added in brackets. e.g. FANZCVS (Veterinary Behaviour).
- 4. Only when a veterinarian has passed examinations for Membership and Fellowship in different subjects, shall he/she be entitled to list both the membership and fellowship qualifications. In this situation subject names are to be added e.g. MANZCVS (Small Animal Medicine), FANZCVS (Dermatology).
- 5. Members or Fellows of the College who become unfinancial or who resign from the College are no longer permitted to append postnominals referring to College qualifications.
